



FRIDAY, October 4th through SUNDAY October 6th, 2019

TIME: You may begin arriving at the campground at 3:00 p.m. on Friday. Dinner will be served at approximately 6:00 p.m. on Friday. Come early and take a walk with your son through the fort!

DESTINATION: Fort Flagler Historical State Park (Wagon Wheel group site) 10541 Flagler Road, Norland WA 98358.

WHAT: Fun and fellowship, games, Council Fire, singing and devotionals with boys and men of Gateway. We will have a worship leader and guest speaker for our Council Fire. Royal Rangers will be doing the cooking and cleanup for you, so that you can visit and relax with your boy and “the guys”.

WHO: Open to *all* Fathers, Grandpas, Uncles, Guardians, and their boys who attend Gateway Fellowship are friends of Gateway attenders, plus our Leaders, boys and young men of Royal Rangers Outpost 135 at Gateway. Note: Royal Ranger boys can come without Dad, *but you'll need to tell us if that's your situation.* Rangers on this campout without a parent or legal guardian will need to complete a Royal Ranger Emergency Medical Information Form, available on the CCB website. Ranger Kids (ages 5-6-7) *must* be accompanied by your Dad or a legal guardian.

COST: **\$50.00 per person** (for all meals from Friday dinner through Sunday breakfast, snacks, campsite fee, parking fee.) **Note:** The \$50.00 campout fee is due by the deadline on Wednesday, October 2nd!

TRANSPORTATION: You will need to drive yourselves to the campground.

PARKING: The park charges a parking fee for all camp attendees' cars, trucks and RV's. If you have a Washington State Park Discover Pass, *please bring it with you* and show it to the Park Ranger. Also, please tell John Garland or Bob Laschinski that you have a Discover Pass so we can reconcile the parking charges with the Park Ranger.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: *Wednesday, October 2nd.* Due to the size of the group, we will need the 2 days of lead-time to plan and buy the food for the campout. Therefore, no registrations will be accepted after the Wednesday deadline date. Thanks for your cooperation!

To Register: Sign up and pay camp fees on the CCB website *You are considered to be registered when camping fees have been paid in full.*

CAMPING EQUIPMENT: We have tents available for up to 50 campers, with the stipulation that a Royal Ranger Commander helps you set it up and take it down. If you have a tent, camper, motorhome, or travel trailer for yourself, please bring it. (Note: There are **no** hook-ups for RV's at the Wagon Wheel Campsite.) Please bring adequate clothing and gear for wet, cool weather, and follow the equipment list attached to this sheet.
